Honoree: Tom Hathaway



Tom Hathaway's life is a true "rags to riches story." Tom came from humble beginnings to be a very successful businessman in Parkersburg. He was born in a cellar home in Calhoun County with his twin sister on March 23, 1941. Tom was a 1958 graduate of Parkersburg High School. Tom went on to attend West Liberty State College before returning to Parkersburg to marry BJ Hupp.

Hathaway started his career in the automobile business working Hupp and Wharton, which eventually became The Wharton Auto Group. He then started a used car lot on Murdoch Avenue in Parkersburg. In 1979 Tom and BJ expanded the business into a new Toyota dealership, Superior Toyota. Hathaway worked many hours to grow the dealership and earn loyal customers. Superior Toyota is the longest running family-run Toyota dealership in West Virginia. Tom was a lifelong member of the West Virginia Auto and Truck Dealers Association.

Tom guided Superior Toyota from its humble beginnings, through many of the struggles that all entrepreneurs face, to become one of the most successful family run businesses in Parkersburg. Tom and Superior Toyota have always been supporters of Parkersburg and the Mid-Ohio Valley. Superior has become one of the largest supporters of Mid-Ohio Valley charities through its avid support of the Parkersburg Area Community Foundation.

Tom, along with BJ, was an avid golfer and member of the Parkersburg Country Club. Tom spent many days playing golf with his friends and family.

Tom Hathaway passed away on October 5, 2016.
